### International awards five scholarships to support future transportation professionals in Huntsville and Tulsa

Recipients were selected based on:

- Academic performance
- Demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities
- Work experience
- A statement of educational and career goals and objectives
- Unusual personal or family circumstances
- An online recommendation

- Financial need
