In addition, Shriver selected the 72" high-rise sleeper with Eagle black tuck-and-roll leather interior, full chrome package including bright finish exhaust, polished stainless steel air cleaners, bright polished fuel tanks, polished aluminum wheels and a premium sound package with satellite radio. Finally, the truck was spec'd with a power inverter with shore power, refrigerator and full gauge package.

Shriver received the truck keys from Tom Lerch, regional vice president of International Truck and Engine.

"Just as Henry takes a great deal of care to maintain his safety and on-time delivery record, International has taken a great deal of care in spec'ing out this truck," said Lerch. "He exemplifies the quality men and women we have come to rely on in this industry, and it has been an honor being here today to share in his success and celebrate with his loved ones."
